PROJECT 3

PROJECT TITLE	Paper, Poster & Presentation
PROJECT DESCRIPTION	This is a three-part assignment comprised of a research paper written about a designer chosen from the list given, a poster designed about your chosen subject (<i>done in the style of the designer</i>), and a class presentation you will need to give about your chosen subject.
PROJECT GOALS	<p>Part 1: The Paper</p> <p>You will need to research a designer from the list given and write a 1000 word report summarizing the designer's background, education and career accomplishments, followed by your reaction to the designer's work. The paper must be typed (<i>12pt, Times New Roman, double-spaced</i>) and presented in a presentation folder, citing all references, including websites in a bibliography. Research MUST be gathered from books or credible websites. <i>This part of the assignment fulfills your significant writing assignment for this course.</i></p> <p>Part 2: The Poster</p> <p>You will also be required to design a poster about your designer. Your poster design should included the highlights of the designer's background, education and career accomplishments that you touched on in your paper. The poster should be designed at a 11" x 17" format (<i>or 17" x 11" format if you wish, remember it is always width first when talking about dimensions</i>). You can use illustrations, photography or a mixture of mediums but the poster must be designed/laid out in InDesign. Your final poster will be printed in color at full-size (<i>it however does not need to be mounted</i>).</p> <p>Part 3: The Presentation</p> <p>Lastly you will be required to present a 10-minute oral, audio-visual presentation to the class, showcasing the designer and their work.* The presentation must include a photo of the designer and at least 10 samples of that designer's work. The slide presentation also must have a footnotes or a credit page, citing references to quotes and images used. Your presentation should also be designed/laid out as a multi-page PDF in InDesign.</p> <p><i>*The research paper may be read aloud during the presentation, while you navigate through your PDF formatted presentation, using the classroom AV equipment.</i></p> <p>The PDF finals for your poster and presentation will need to be uploaded to the Blackboard File Exchange folder for the project on the day the project is due. PDFs should be saved with the following format: First Initial > Last Name - ART140 - Project# - Format.pdf (i.e. <i>FLastname-ART140-Project3-Poster.pdf</i> or <i>FLastname-ART140-Project3-Presentation</i>).</p>
