**PROJECT DESCRIPTION** 

For your second project you must design your opening exhibition for your new museum as well as a poster for the exhibition.

There are many ways to approach this exhibit design from something as simple as a timeline of the important dates about your subject all the way up to an exhibit where visitors are encouraged to physically interact in some way with an important concept that educates them in the nuances of your museum's subject.

This exhibit mock-up can be done in either Illustrator or Photoshop, it must be high resolution (300 *dpi* or *better*). The poster design can be done in either Illustrator or InDesign. You will not need to print or mount this project as we will display them on the projector for final critique. But must show in great detail as to how the exhibit is set up for the audience.
