Graphic Techniques CEX2 Separations & Spots

Working with Separations

GOAL:

Observe how color is separated from the digital document to the printer.

DESIGN:

Create a 3-color design using spot colors.

RULES TO LIVE BY: ONE COLOR = ONE PLATE

The commercial press color is not printed all together, it prints one color at a time whether it is individual spot colors or cyan, magenta, yellow, and black.

IN A DIGITAL DOCUMENT:

BLACK IS A COLOR; WHITE IS THE COLOR OF THE PAPER

1. Open InDesign

- 2. Create a document with the following specs:
 - Page size: Letter
 - Orientation: Vertical
 - Margins: can be 1/2" or 0.5 in
 - Bleed: 1/8" or 0.125 in
- 3. Open up the Swatch Palette
- 4. Under the Palette Option Menu select New Color Swatch
- 5. In the New Color Swatch select the following options:
 - Color mode: Select PANTONE Solid Coated
 - Select PMS 123 (yellow) / Click ADD
 - Select PMS 194 (red) / Click ADD
 - Select PMS 2765 (blue) / Click DONE
- 6. SAVE FILE AS: Separations-Lastname.indd
- 7. Using the RECTANGLE TOOL create a rectangle the size of the document.
- 8. Extend the shape to the bleed lines.
- 9. Select a color from the Swatch Palette for the fill color of the rectangle.
- 10. Using either the ELLIPSE OR POLYGON TOOL create three or more shapes of various sizes on the page.
 - Make sure at least one object overlaps the edge of the page.
- 11. Using another color, select a color from the Swatch Palette for the fill color of the three new shapes.

(three new shapes should be the same color)

- 12. Create a Text box in Document.
- 13. Type in Your First Name.
- 14. Typeset your name, so that it is bold in style and large in size.
- 15. Position your name so that it overlaps a object on the page.
- 16. SAVE
- 17. Go to the Menu Bar to File>Print
- 18. In the Print Window
- 19. Under MARKS AND BLEEDS: Select: CROP MARKS, BLEED MARKS & PAGE INFORMATION
- 20. Under OUTPUT : Select SEPARATIONS for COLOR
- 21. Deselect: CMYK inks
- 22. Click PRINT
